

Declaration of compliance

Introduction

The directive (EC) 1935/2004 concerning food contact and the directive (EU) Nr.10/2011 concerning plastic additives of the European Parliament that regulates plastics that are intended to come into contact with foodstuffs. Principle is that food contact materials should be safe and not transfer their components or additives into the foodstuff, (migration) in unacceptable quantities. The EU legislation for food contact materials is based on positive lists of the substances and maximum limits of migration into food. Only substances on these positive lists may be used for manufacturing plastics that are designated to have food contact. Furthermore, analyses regarding global and specific migration are required. This must be available on request from authorities.


The Food and Drug Administration of the United States is the world's best known authority involved in consumer protection in respect of potential detrimental influences, which could be caused by any inclusion of substances or ingredients of an unacceptable nature in foodstuffs and confectionery. The FDA has prepared a review 'Title 21: Code of Federal Regulations' in respect of their approval of the raw materials in a processed or finished state, and also specified the conditions under which the approval is valid.
