Market opportunities in Tanzania

Tanzania, with its large and growing domestic population, abundance of agricultural resources, economic and political stability, presents an attractive market opportunity for water/ food related companies.

Tanzania is a rapidly growing emerging market; it ranks among the 20 fastest growing economies in the world. The country has exhibited a GDP growth rate of around 7% for past 5 years. The population of approx. 45 mio. is the largest in East Africa and its new middle-class is growing and creating a fast demand for variety and better products.

Tanzania has the largest agricultural sector in East Africa, accounting for 28 % of the country's GDP, growing approx. 6 % per year, employs nearly 80% of its workforce. The large and growing agribusiness generates a natural center for the food industry attracting foreign companies. Many international food processing, dairy and beverage companies have set up local production and serve the rest of continent from Tanzania.

The industry needs safer and more efficient food processing technology and to set up more food processing facilities to handle the growing input from the agribusiness; fruit and vegetables, juices, edible oils, meat, dairy products etc.

At the same time, there is a constant focus on savings in water consumption and the potential for recycling of water in the industry and created opportunities for new solutions and components for water-saving technologies. The business opportunities in this area includes access to clean water, water treatment, water distribution, water quality and wastewater.

Price and terms of participation

The price of participation is: **9.900,- DKK** ex VAT for the full event + 4.900,- DKK members of DWTG or DFTG / 9.800,- DKK non-members

The price includes airfare and hotel accommodation (3 nights) for 1 person.


