

### **FASCINATING FACTS: MEDICAL AIDS** MARKET GERMANY

The health economy is one of the biggest and most important submarkets of the Germany economy. In 2014, EUR 327.9 billion were spent on health. Roughly 90 percent of the population of Germany have statutory health insurance and are entitled to receive benefits to maintain and restore their health, or to improve their state of health. As a rule, statutory health insurance providers only cover the cost of a medical aid if the product is listed in the German approved medical aids register (Hilfsmittelverzeichnis). A product can be listed in the approved medical aids register upon application by the manufacturer and if certain properties and qualities are proven.

In Germany, many people are willing to pay for medical aids and services on their own. The private market for medical aids is growing very fast and covers a volume of EUR 6 billion every year.

#### THE MAIN PARTIES IN THE MEDICAL AIDS MARKET

The structure of the medical aids market is highly varied. There are many other people and organisations that provide those insured with medical aids, such as:

- healthcare technicians (prosthetists and orthotists, as well as orthopaedic footwear professionals). These technicians provide hands-on and technical services. Their main job is to manufacture and fit medical aids that compensate for reduced or lacking mobility.
- retailers of medical supplies and healthcare supplies shops. These retailers provide industrially manufactured medical and orthopaedic aids for people with illnesses and disabilities. These aids include bandages, compression stockings, home care products, wheelchairs and support aids, among other things.

As the leading professional association for orthopaedic technology and conceptual partner to OTWorld, the German Association for Orthopaedic Technology (Bundesinnungsverband für Orthopädie-Technik) represents around 2,300 healthcare supplies shops and P&O workshops, with around 37,000 employees in Germany.\*\*\*


