Transfers of personal data to countries outside the EU/EEA is not permitted unless the supplier has implemented technical measures ensuring that the supplier or third parties, including authorities, in the country of destination cannot access the data "in the clear", e.g. by encrypting the data and storing the decryption key separate at an EU/EEA based supplier that is solely under the jurisdiction of the European Union Member States and Member State law so only that EU/EEA based party (e.g. the Danish Competition and Consumer Authority) can read/decrypt data.
