Facts on the Polish water and wastewater sector

- The largest water use occurs in the industrial sector, followed by public consumption.
- Continued urbanization, industrialization and increasing population is putting pressure on Poland's water resources to be managed effectively with a particular focus on wastewater management. Acc. EU directive to Poland until 2015 to establish 177 new wastewater treatment plants, upgrade 569 systems and establish 30,000 km sanitation.
- Investment allocated to flood alert programme: PLN 516 m allocated to counteract and dispose of the effects of natural disasters (i.e. floods).
- Industrial water is about 70% of the total water consumption. Recycling of industrial water presents great potential.
- In addition to implementing wastewater treatment, energy efficiency in the industry is an area with great savings potential.
- Poland does not manufacture specialist water sector equipment and there is strong demand for high quality products in this area;
 - supplying sewage treatment plants;
 - monitoring and measuring equipment and sludge treatment equipment;
 - pipes, fittings and wells, hydraulic units, pumps and plumbing fittings;
 - machines and appliances for building, repairing and maintenance of
 - water supply and sewage network
